We anticipate the 2021-22 school year will look more like a typical school year ... with safety measures

In-person learning

- School will be held in person 5 full days a week.
- Teachers will be physically present in classrooms.
- Virus safety protocols will continue, including masks for everyone, hand sanitization, and bathroom and lunch protocols.
- Social distancing: 3 ft between student desks. 6 ft between adults and students.
- Masks required for outdoor activities such as recess and physical education in alignment with CDC recommendations.
- Students will attend their neighborhood school or assigned choice school
- Middle schools will start slightly later in the morning. Elementary schools' start times will shift slightly. Thursdays will be early release days at all school sites. (Bell schedule is here)
- Masked, vaccinated volunteers will be allowed at school sites. <u>More information on volunteering</u>.
- The status of field trips/activities is in process
- Parent meetings such as SSC, ELAC, Parent University etc. will be virtual
- Performing arts events may be permitted in our outdoor amphitheaters
- Activities/electives such as band and choir will be held with modifications.
