To promote transparency and open communication with the community, employees and other interested individuals, the Board of Trustees of the Mountain View Whisman School District has asked its team to provide accurate, factual and timely updates about negotiations with MVEA.



This is the District's fourth Negotiations News regarding 2018-2019 bargaining, **June 5, 2018 Session**.

Tentative Agreement reached

Yesterday, the District and Mountain View Educators Association (MVEA) completed 2018-2019 negotiations and reached a comprehensive tentative agreement.

Highlights include a 5% salary schedule increase effective July 1, 2018, as well as annual stipends for master's and doctorate degrees, and National Board Certification (\$2,000 each for no more than two). Additional amendments were made to Article 3 (Hours) and Article 7 (Class Size).

The tentative agreement will be presented to MVEA members on August 14. Pending ratification, the Board will consider the tentative agreement for approval at its September 6 Board meeting. Both teams are pleased that these negotiations have been completed before the start of the 18-19 school year.
