

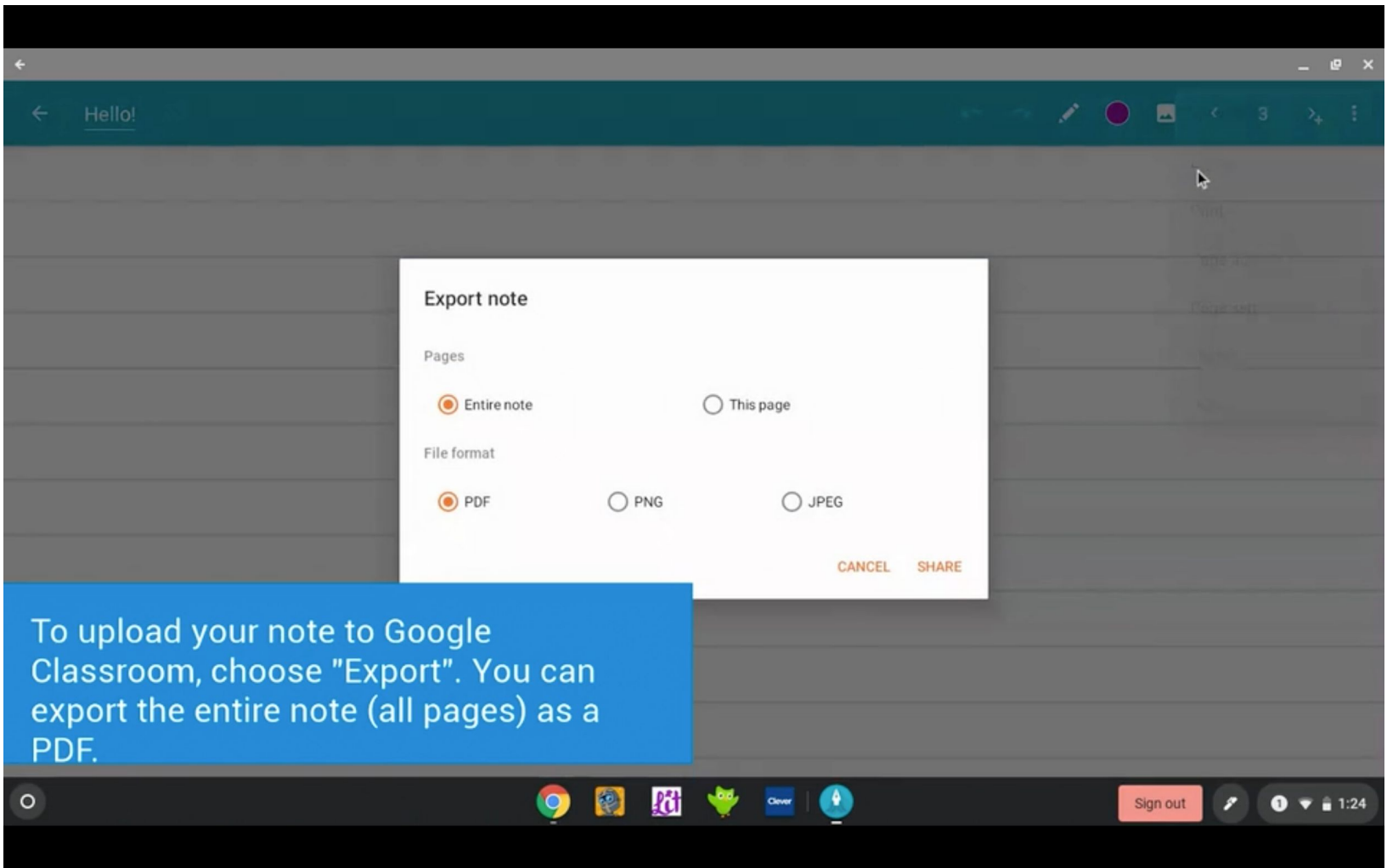


Use the arrows on the side of the page numbers to add pages to your note. Your note can have unlimited pages.

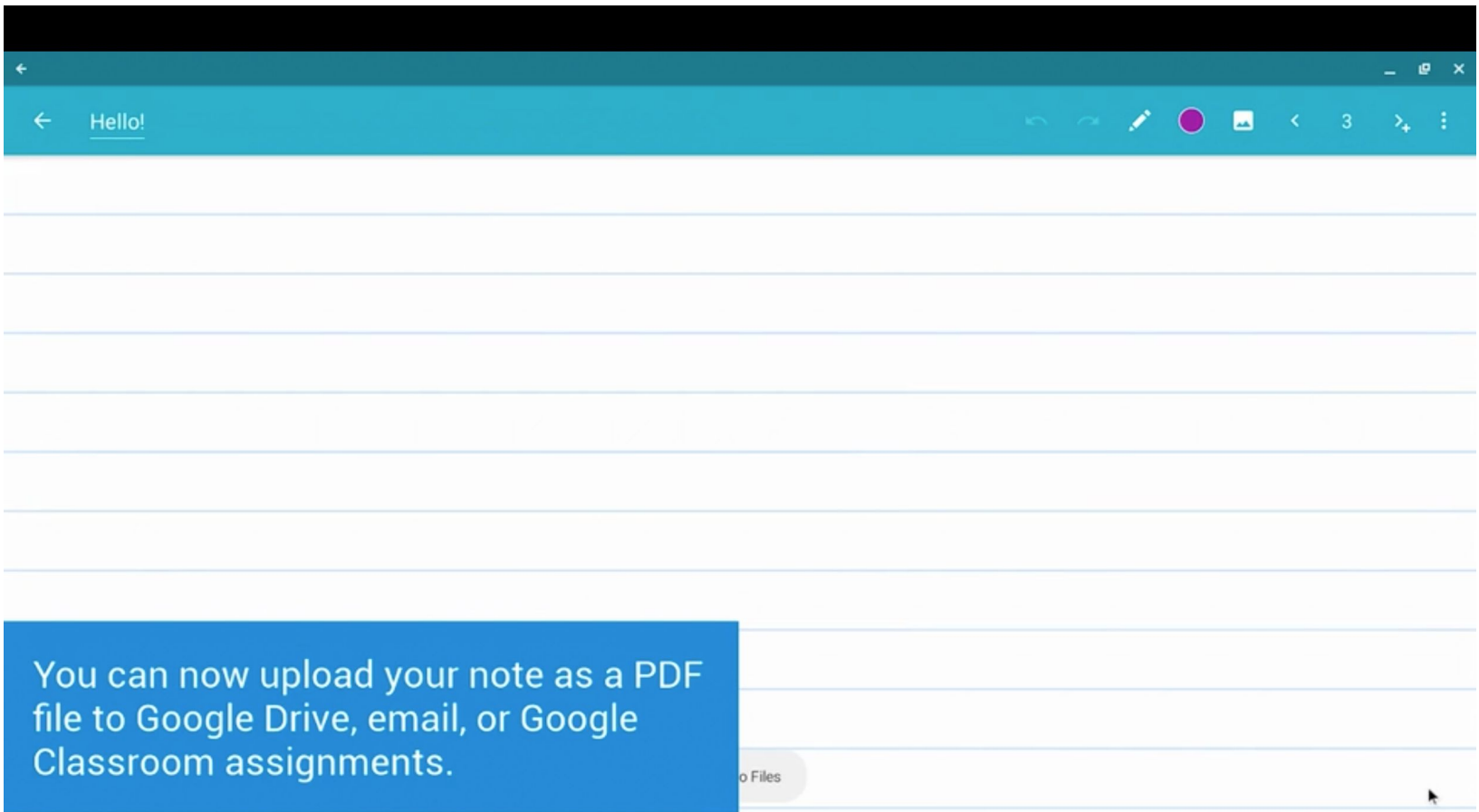




Use the 3 dots to access a menu for page settings and more for your note.
